Celebrating the values of festive gifting, the merry gathering could also celebrate the joy of generosity — in a charitable auction, brilliantly orchestrated by Head of Sales, Guy Caquelin, Bugatti organized to support the Semeurs d'Étoiles, a local charity with whom the brand has forged close ties with, and whose mission centers upon the care and wellbeing of hospitalized children as well as fully assisting their parents. A car bonnet adorned with hand-drawn sketches from Jascha Straub, Bugatti's Lead Designer Sur Mesure, was presented before all. With the final patron, The Singh Collection, Punjab, India — proud owners of the W16 Mistral World Record Car — donating €50,000, they offered the piece as a gift to Mate Rimac, a beautiful celebration of generosity and giving thanks for the amazing year they had shared with the marque, including setting the open-top speed world record with their very own W16 Mistral car. An authentic tribute to the shared values symbolized in owning a Bugatti.
