

WOLFGANG GLABUS JOINS BUGATTI AS NEW COMMUNICATIONS DIRECTOR



Wolfgang Glabus (52) has been appointed Communications Director for Bugatti Automobiles S.A.S. effective September 1, 2012. He will report directly to Dr. Wolfgang Schreiber, new President of Bugatti from September 1, 2012 onwards. "With Wolfgang Glabus we have won an experienced communications and media expert, who will contribute to the further enhancement of the Bugatti brand", Dr Schreiber said.
